

BOARD MEMBER SPOTLIGHT DANIEL W "WOODY" FUTRELL



Woody Futrell's dedication to the Arkansas State Police comes naturally. His grandfather, Governor Junius Marion Futrell, signed the Chrip-Carter bill into law (ACT 120) on March 19, 1935, creating the Arkansas State Police force, known then as Arkansas Rangers.

Woody served as an appointed member to Arkansas State Police Commission (1993-2015) and the Arkansas Racing Commission (1978-1993) by Governors Pryor, Clinton, Tucker, Huckabee and Beebe. He served as Chair of the State Police Commission three terms. After leaving the Commission, Woody joined the ASP Foundation as a founding member of the Board of Directors. Born in Batesville, Woody was raised in Nashville which continues to be his home. He won his first boat race at the age of 12 and continued racing for many years. He got his pilot's license at age 17 and was a multi-engine private pilot for 60 years. Woody was very active in sports at Nashville High School, playing football, basketball and running track. He attended Henderson State Teachers College (now HSU) where he played football and graduated in 1963 with a BA degree in Business. Following graduation, he served in the Army Reserves for six years.

He and his father, Dan Futrell, owned and operated Futrell Marine in Nashville and Futrell Aircraft in Hot Springs.

Today, Woody is still involved with Futrell Marine which has expanded to Hot Springs and Heber Springs. Woody served on the Board of Directors of the Prescott Savings and Loan and Nashville Savings and Loan. An avid hunter and fisherman, Woody is the consummate sportsman. Because of his unyielding commitment to the outdoors, in 2019, Woody was inducted into the Arkansas Game and Fish Foundation

Outdoor Hall of Fame. Woody is extremely proud to serve on the ASP Foundation Executive Board and as Advisor to the Troop G Spouses' Auxiliary. He was awarded the Foundation Hall of Fame Award in 2020. Woody is the proud father of a son and daughter and grandfather of five grandchildren.
