### **Board Member Spotlight**

#### **ELIZABETH BURNS ANDERSON**

A fifth-generation banker and native of Magnolia, Elizabeth Burns Anderson is Senior Vice President of Farmers Bank and Trust and Executive Director of the Farmers Bank Foundation. She is a graduate of the University of Arkansas and in 2020, Governor Asa Hutchinson appointed Elizabeth to the Arkansas State Medical Board where she will serve until 2027. As Secretary of the Lonoke School Board, Elizabeth chaired a successful mileage tax campaign and capital campaign to raise over \$16 million to bring agriculture and rural healthcare education to Lonoke Public



Schools through workforce education. In 2022, she was awarded the vision and leadership award by Lonoke Public Schools.



Elizabeth comes from a family where giving back is your greatest responsibility. She has been on many boards across Central Arkansas and chairman of almost all of them. Lonoke Community Fund, an affiliate of the Arkansas Community Foundation, Lonoke Century League, Youth Home, and Arkansas State Police Foundation Board, and many more. In 2021, Elizabeth joined the statewide board of THE CALL, which supports foster families in Arkansas, she serves as their board Vice Chair. Elizabeth is a recipient of the Lonoke Chamber of Commerce Citizen of the Year in 2023. Elizabeth is also a graduate of the Arkansas Chamber Leadership Class and the F.B.I citizen's academy.

Elizabeth and her husband Jamie, who is Vice President of Anderson Fish Farms, the world's largest bait industry farm, were named the 2019 Arkansas Farm Family of the year. Elizabeth was the keynote speaker at the 2022-A Arkansas State Police Trooper graduation. She continues to support the Arkansas State Police and a collaboration of community and law enforcement for a safer Arkansas. Elizabeth and Jamie have 2 boys and live in Scott, Arkansas.

### Trooper Retiree Spotlight

BEN D. CROSS

Benjamin David Cross was born on August 20, 1969, and he currently resides with his wife, Tammy Leann Cross, in Dover, Arkansas. Cross graduated from Dover High School and attended Arkansas Tech University and the University of Arkansas at Little Rock. Later he attended the School of Law Enforcement Supervision at UALR. Cross is a veteran of the US Army, served with Russellville Police Department from 1990-1995, became an Arkansas State Trooper in 1995, and proudly retired in 2019 as Assistant Troop Commander of Troop H.

After a 30-year law enforcement career and prior and concurrent military service, including a combat deployment to the Middle East. Cross sought out and was elected in May 2018 as the County Judge in Pope County. Previously, Cross was elected to the Pope County Quorum Court in 2011 and finished his third term of service in that capacity in 2018. Upon his retirement from active law enforcement, he had amassed a career that positioned Cross as one of the most decorated troopers in the history of Arkansas State Police.





Some of the awards achieved by Cross include the following: 1997 – ASP Lifesaving Award, 2004 – Arkansas Law Enforcement Officer of the Year, 2005 – ASP Medal of Valor, 2005 – ASP – Trooper of the Year, 2011 – "Best of the Best" Police Officer Award, Arkansas River Valley, and 2014 – ASP Medal of Valor.

He maintains an active law enforcement certification in a reserve capacity with the Pope County Sheriff's Office. As the past Vice-Chairmen of the Board of Trustees for the Arkansas State Police Retirement System, he managed over \$300 million in assets. As the Pope County Judge, Cross manages around 300 employees and serves as chief executive officer for the county while actively advancing infrastructure in Pope County.



### **New ASP Major Spotlight**

PLEASE WELCOME MAJOR RON CASEY

Major Casey was born and raised in Mena, AR where he attended and graduated from Acorn High School in Polk County in 1984. Major Casey started his law enforcement career in May of 1989 in the City of Grannis and he worked there until September of 1990 when he went to work for the Mena Police Department. Major Casey states, "I began my dream job as an Arkansas State Trooper in September of 1992. My first assignment was as a highway patrol trooper in Grant County, Sheridan, where I still live. I have been in the Highway Patrol Division all my career except for 13 months

when I was the ASP Fleet Manager. I have been very fortunate and blessed to move up to my present position of Major, Commander of the Highway Patrol Division." Major Casey attended Arkansas Leader, a supervision school at CJI in 2016 and graduated from the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy in September of 2019. He has been married to his wife Amy for almost 28 years and they have two children who are both in college. Major Casey shares the following, "I have wholeheartedly supported the Foundation Auxiliary since its inception. They are truly exceptional and have a very strong voice for our troopers. They get done what we can't. I am very excited to work for the current administration and believe the state police have a bright future. The troopers and their families need to know that this administration is going to work hard for them."


