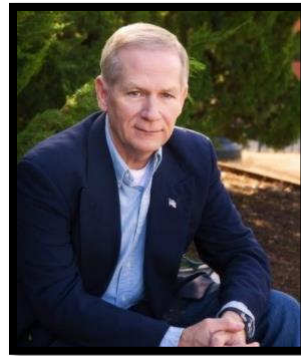

The Foundation Board bids farewell to **RETIRED LT. GENERAL MARK H. BERRY.** State Representative Mark H. Berry received his B.S. degree in Aeronautics from Embry-Riddle

Aeronautical University and his Master of Public Administration from Golden State University. After 21 years of active military service and 24 years with the Air National Guard, Berry was appointed Director of the Arkansas Military Department and Adjutant General of the Arkansas National Guard by Governor Asa Hutchinson. In that position, he joined the ASPF Board as a special advisor to the Foundation Executive Board. He provided critical service and advice during the beginning stages of building the precision driving training track at Camp Robinson and, because of his valuable assistance, the Foundation’s vision for a first-class driving training facility is a reality. His experience as past president of the National Guard Association of Arkansas prompted him to encourage the Foundation to move forward with plans for the ASPF Spouses’ Auxiliary and he has served as an Advisor to Troop H Auxiliary. He retired in 2019 and was elected to the Arkansas House of Representatives representing District 82, which includes portions of Franklin, Madison, and Crawford Counties. The Board appreciates Representative Berry for his outstanding contributions while on the Foundation Board and we look forward to continuing to work with him in his new role in the Arkansas Legislature.

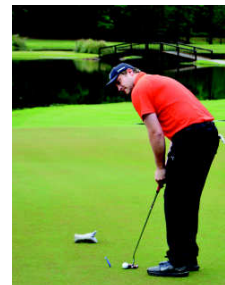
